

# LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY

*Luke 11:1 • Matthew 6:9-13*

## 1. RENDEZVOUS (WITH THE LORD)

We can say, “Abba Father” (Ro. 8:15), because: “Our Father which art in heaven...” (Mat. 6:9).

“Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus” (Heb. 10:19).

Hallow means to praise. “Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name” (Ps. 100:4).

**Praise God As: Name:**

**Meaning:**

(1) Creator	<b>ELOHIM</b>	One Who is great (Used 32 times in Gen. 1) Mighty, majestic and suggests Trinity.
(2) Father	<b>EL SHADDAI</b>	Almighty God Who is mighty to completely nourish, satisfy and supply us (Gen. 17:1).
	<b>EL ROI</b>	The strong One Who sees (Gen. 16:13).
	<b>EL O LAM</b>	Everlasting God (Is. 40:28; Gen. 21:33).
(3) Lord	<b>ADONAI</b>	The God Who is owner and ruler over everything (Is. 6:1).

“That men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth” (Ps. 83:18). Praise Jehovah, “I AM THAT I AM,” the Covenant name of God (Ex. 6:3-4).

**Meaning:**

<b>JEHOVAH-TSIDKENU</b>	“I AM YOUR RIGHTEOUSNESS” (Jer. 23:6)
<b>JEHOVAH-M’KADDESHI</b>	“I AM YOUR SANCTIFICATION” (Ex. 31:13)
<b>JEHOVAH-SHALOM</b>	“I AM YOUR PEACE” (Jud. 6:24)
<b>JEHOVAH-SHAMMAH</b>	“I AM PRESENT WITH YOU” (Ezek. 48:35)
<b>JEHOVAH-RAPHA</b>	“I AM YOUR HEALING” (Ex. 15:26)
<b>JEHOVAH-JIREH</b>	“I AM YOUR PROVISION” (Gen. 22:13,14)
<b>JEHOVAH- EL GMOLAH</b>	“I AM YOUR RECOMPENSE” (Jer. 51:56)
<b>JEHOVAH-NISSI</b>	“I AM YOUR BANNER” (Ex. 17:15)
<b>JEHOVAH-ROHI</b>	“I AM YOUR SHEPHERD” (Ps. 23:1)
<b>JEHOVAH-NAKEH</b>	“I AM THE LORD WHO SMITES” (Ezek. 7-9)
<b>JEHOVAH-ELYON</b>	“I AM THE LORD MOST HIGH” (Ps. 97:9)
<b>JEHOVAH-SABAOTH</b>	“I AM THE LORD OF HOSTS” (1 Sam. 1:3)

## 2. REIGNING (THROUGH THE LORD)

*“Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done...” (Mat. 6:10).*

- “They which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ” (Rom. 5:17).
- “For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink: but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost” (Rom. 14:17).
- “For the kingdom of God is not in word, but in power” (1 Cor. 4:20).

### Righteousness, Peace, Joy and Power for:

- A. You
- B. Family
- C. Church (Pastor, deacons, Sunday School teachers, harvest)
- D. Nation: “I exhort therefore, that first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty” (1 Tim. 2:1-2).

## 3. RECEIVING (FROM THE LORD)

*“Give us this day our daily bread” (Mat. 6:11).*

- A. Centered in the Will of God (Rom. 12:2; 1 Jn. 2:17)
- B. Confident of the Lord’s Provision (Phil. 4:19; 3 Jn. 2)
- C. Continuous in Pursuit (Mat. 7:7; Lk. 18:1-8)

## 4. RETURNING (TO THE LORD)

*“And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors” (Mat. 6:12).*

- A. Confession to God (1 Jn. 1:9)
- B. Compassion to Others (Mat. 18:21-35)
- C. Controlled Temperament (Ja. 1:20; Ps. 141:3; Ps. 119:165)

## 5. RESISTING (IN THE LORD)

*“And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil...” (Mat. 6:13).*

### Put on the armor of God: (Eph. 6:12-17)

- A. Loins Girt about with Truth
- B. Breastplate of Righteousness
- C. Feet Shod with the Preparation of the Gospel of Peace
- D. Shield of Faith
- E. Helmet of Salvation
- F. Sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God

## 6. RECOGNITION (OF THE LORD)

*“For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen” (Mat. 6:13).*

- A. Christ’s Dominion—“the kingdom” (Mat. 16:18)
- B. Christ’s Dynamic Force—“the power” (Zech. 4:6; Eph. 5:18)
- C. Christ’s Designation—“the glory” (Eph. 3:21)



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
